

TEXAS FELLOWSHIP OUTDOORS - RULES AND RELEASE

Welcome - We are happy you are attending an event with Texas Fellowship Outdoors. To ensure a safe and rewarding experience, we ask that you, your children, and/or minors under your supervision observe the following rules.

1. Everyone must read the rules & sign a release before activities begin.
2. All children under the age of 16 **MUST** have adult supervision at all times.
3. No one is allowed behind any fences without permission and must be accompanied by event/ranch staff
4. Event/Ranch vehicles & equipment may not be used unless permission is obtained from the event coordinator
5. All Hunting/Shooting activities & firearms usage!
 - Standard gun safety practices will be followed at all times.
 - Loaded weapons will not be transported in vehicles
 - No ammunition will be put in clips before reaching the gate at the fenced areas or hunting areas.
 - All guns will be unloaded with clips removed before leaving hunting/gated area
 - When more than one hunter is present, there will be only one shooter at a time
 - Guns are to be locked in vehicles in the evenings at all times
6. Water activities
 - Swimming is allowed but no lifeguard is provided. Swim at your own risk.
 - No diving is allowed, water depth varies from 2-6 ft depending on property
 - Absolutely no water activities without parental supervision for children under the age of 16.
 - Anyone under the age of 13 is required to use a lifejacket. No exceptions
7. Fishing - All fishing is catch and release and we ask that barbless hooks are used!
8. No alcohol policy is enforced. No individual who has consumed alcohol in a given day will be allowed to participate in hunting and/or shooting activities until the following day.
9. Food & Drinks – Please keep food & drinks in the common areas only.
10. All buildings and facilities are non-smoking

Release

I have read the rules and take full responsibility for my safety and the safety of my children and/or minors under my supervision. I accept full responsibility for all risks associated with activities and will not hold Texas Fellowship Outdoors and it's officers, employees, related parties, or volunteers responsible for any loss, damage or cost.

The undersigned hereby fully releases and forever discharges, covenants not to sue, and agrees to indemnify from any loss, liability, cost or fees, Texas Fellowship Outdoors, and its agents, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, and related parties (collectively the "Releasees"), from any and every claim, demand, action, or right of action of whatsoever kind of nature, either in law or in equity, arising from or by reason of any bodily injury or personal injuries known or unknown, death and/or property damage resulting, directly or indirectly, from my/our participation in activities attended with Fellowship Texas Outdoors, WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE SIMPLE OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE.

I expressly agree that this release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Texas, and that if any portion of this agreement is held invalid, the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. This release, waiver, and indemnity agreement shall be binding on all heirs, administrators, successors and assigns.
